Find, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15074(b), after consideration of the whole of the administrative record, including the Mitigated Negative Declaration, No. ENV-2014-726-MND ("Mitigated Negative Declaration"), and all comments received, with the imposition of mitigation measures, there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment; FIND the Mitigated Negative Declaration reflects the independent judgment and analysis of the City; Find the mitigation measures have been made enforceable conditions on the project; and Adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and the Mitigation Monitoring Program prepared for the Mitigated Negative Declaration
- 2. **Deny** the appeal in part, and **Sustain**, in part, the Deputy Advisory Agency's determination to approve the Vesting Tentative Tract.
- 3. Adopt the Conditions of Approval, as modified by the Commission; and
- 4. **Adopt** the findings as amended by the Commission.
