Appeal Recommendation Reports are hyperlinked to the case numbers on the agendas. If you are appealing a determination of an Associate Zoning Administrator (AZA), please note that the letter of determination is the report which is forwarded to the Commission. Appeal Recommendation Reports are not prepared for AZA appeals. The Commission may consider the entire action even if only a portion of the action has been appealed.

TESTIMONY AND CORRESPONDENCE - Your attendance is optional; oral testimony can only be given at the hearing and may be limited due to time constraints. Written testimony or evidentiary documentation may be submitted prior to the hearing. Commissions function in a quasi-judicial capacity and therefore, cannot be contacted directly. Any materials submitted to the Department or Commission become City property and <u>will not</u> be returned. This includes any correspondence or exhibits used as part of your testimony.

Be advised that the Commission may RECONSIDER and alter its action taken on items listed on the meeting agenda at any time during this meeting or during the next regular meeting, in accordance with the Commission Policies and Procedures and provided that the Commission retains jurisdiction over the case.
