PROPOSED PROJECT:

The sale and dispensing of beer and wine for on-site consumption in conjunction with an existing 1,446 square-foot bar and pool hall with 62 seats, with live entertainment and public dancing within a 65 square-foot dance floor. The proposed hours of operation are 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily.

APPEAL:

Appeal of the Zoning Administrator's determination to deny the following:

1. Pursuant to Section 12.24 W.1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), a Conditional Use Permit for the sale and dispensing of beer and wine for on-site consumption in conjunction with an existing bar and pool hall;
2. Pursuant to LAMC Section 12.24 W.18, a Conditional Use Permit to allow live entertainment and public dancing in conjunction with an existing bar and pool hall; and
3. Pursuant to LAMC Section 12.24 W.27, a Conditional Use Permit to allow a deviation from the Mini Shopping Center/ Commercial Corner Development provisions to allow operating hours of 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily, in lieu of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily.

The Commission may also consider an Exemption from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15305 (Class 5) and City CEQA Guidelines, Section 1, Article 3, Class 5, Category 23; and that there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception to a categorical exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 applies.
