 - On Tuesday, August 21, the Planning and Land Use Management Committee approved a proposed Ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to increase the number of adult dogs permitted to be kept overnight in pet shops in certain commercial zones with development and operation standards. The purpose of the proposed ordinance is to encourage pet adoptions in the City of Los Angeles.
 - On Thursday, August 23, the City Planning Commission will consider an amendment that will add a provision to the Zoning Code establishing a procedure for appealing CEQA determinations, such as Categorical Exemptions, Mitigated Negative Declarations, and Environmental Impact Reports, to the City Council.
