#### DEPARTMENTAL REPORTAND COMMISSION BUSINESS

Michelle Senior City Planner distributed the Department's Housing Report and gave a brief
update stating that the Housing Report had been released by the Department in July which
highlights the success post-Measure JJJ as there have been 6,485 housing units approved. In
November of 2016, Measure JJJ was approved which requires that developers provide
affordable housing if the project requires a General Plan Amendment, Zone Change or Height
District Change. Recently, we have seen a spike of projects which are opting to use the Transit
Oriented Community (TOC) guidelines.

#### MOTION

Commissioner Bishop put forth the actions below, in conjunction with the approval of the following project:

A wood fence extension on top of a concrete masonry wall in the rear and side yards of the property varying in height from 7 1/2-feet to 9-feet, 2 inches.

- 1. Determine on the whole of the administrative record, that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to City CEQA Guidelines, Section 1, Article 1, Class 3, Category 6 and Class 3, Category 1, and that there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception to a categorical exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 applies;
- 2. Deny the appeal and sustain the Zoning Administrator's determination to approve, in part, a Zoning Administrator's Adjustment, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.28, to permit a fence/wall varying in height from 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-feet to a maximum of 9 feet 2 inches in lieu

of the 6 feet and 8 feet maximum wall/fence heights permitted in the rear and side yards in the R1 Zone; and

3. Adopt the Conditions and Findings of the Zoning Administrator.

Commissioner Beatty seconded the motion, and the vote proceeded as follows.
