# 3. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT



PROJECT SITE: 3755 West Beverly Boulevard; 301 North Juanita Avenue

## **PROPOSED PROJECT:**

Change of use of the first-floor parking garage of an existing three-story building from parking garage to a 6,600 square-foot general office space and the reduction of existing parking spaces from 62 parking spaces to 41 parking spaces. The proposed change of use would serve the second and third-floor medical offices currently existing within the building in the C2-1 Zone within Subarea C (Community Center) of the Vermont/Western Station Neighborhood Area Plan (SNAP).

## **REQUESTED ACTIONS:**

- 1. Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities), an Exemption from CEQA, and that there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception of a categorical exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 applies;
- 2. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 1, 5,7, a Specific Plan Exception from Section 9.E.5(c) of the Vermont/Western SNAP to allow a reduction in the required project parking from 62 parking spaces to 41 parking spaces;
- 3. Pursuant to LAMC Section 11.5.7 C, a Project Permit Compliance to allow a change of use from a first-floor parking garage to a 6,600 square-foot general office space within an existing three-story building.
