<u>The hearing involves</u> an appeal, in part, of the Zoning Administrator's decision to Approve pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections 12.24-L and M, a deemed-to-be approved Conditional Use status and Approval of Plans to allow the continued use and maintenance of an existing crematory, chapel and columbarium, a 1,920 square-foot portion of an outdoor columbarium and reconsideration of Mitigated Negative Declaration no. ENV-2010-1763-MND-REC1. The following Condition of Approval, which prohibits memorial services, is being appealed:

7. There shall be no mortuary operation, embalming of human remains, or associated memorial service on site.
