REQUESTED ACTION: The Zoning Administrator will consider:

- Pursuant to 12.27 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, a Variance from Section 12.11-A to allow the 1. sale and consumption of a full line of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption and patron dancing, in conjunction with an existing 16,087 square-foot building with two banquet halls. As proposed, the banquet halls would be used for private parties only, having a total occupancy of 1,320 persons, also offering live entertainment, with hours of operation from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. daily; to permit 13 off-site parking spaces to be secured by a lease agreement, in lieu of a recorded covenant; all on a 20,064 square-foot site in an R4-1VL Zone.
- Pursuant to Section 21082.1(c)(3) of the California Public Resources Code, adopt the Mitigated 2. Negative Declaration (MND) for the above referenced project.

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations.

Exhaustion Of Administrative Remedies: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.
