REQUESTED ACTION: The Zoning Administrator will consider:

- 1. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 12.24-W,49, a Conditional Use to permit the installation, operation, and maintenance of a new, wireless telecommunication facility (WTF) to be located on the rooftop of an existing 47 foot, 7 inch, three-story commercial building, consisting of 3 sectors totaling: 12 panel antennas, 12 RRU's with A2 Backpack and 2 ray caps per sector, 2 equipment cabinets to be mounted behind wall, and a stand-by generator with 3 GPS antennas located at ground level in the M2-2-O Zone.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 21082.1(c) 3 of the California Public Resources Code, adaption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration, ENV-2014-3834-MND, in conjunction with the above referenced Project.

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will

consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations.

Exhaustion Of Administrative Remedies: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.

<u>Advice To Public</u>: The exact time this report will be considered during the meeting is uncertain since there may be several other items on the agenda. Section 704 oof Title 7 of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (effective February 8, 1996), contains the following language:

No State or local government or instrumentality thereof may regulate the placement, construction, and modification of personal wireless service facilities on the basis of the environmental effects of radio frequency emissions to the extent that such facilities comply with the Commission's regulations concerning such emissions."
