REQUESTED ACTION: The Zoning Administrator will consider:

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.24-X,28 a Zoning Administrator's Determination to permit the construction of a single-family dwelling fronting on a substandard Hillside Limited Street (Calaveras Street, a paper street) that is improved to a roadway width of less than 20 feet as required by Sections 12.21-C,10(i)(2) and a Project Permit Compliance Review (Ordinance No. 168,707) for the construction, use and maintenance of 1,080.95 square feet, three-story, 27 foot and 6 inches in height, single-family dwelling with a detached carport within the Mount Washington-Glassell Park Specific Plan and pursuant to Section 11.5.7.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 21082.1(3) of the California Public Resources Code, adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the above referenced project.

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will

consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations.

Exhaustion Of Administrative Remedies: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.

<u>Advice To Public</u>: The exact time this report will be considered during the meeting is uncertain since there may be several other items on the agenda.
