REQUESTED ACTION: The Zoning Administration will consider:

- 1. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.24-W, 1, a Conditional Use Permit to allow the sale of beer and wine for off-site consumption in conjunction with a proposed 3,520 square-foot convenience store, with proposed 24 hours of operation daily.
- 2. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.24-W, 27, a Conditional Use Permit to allow the 24 hours of operation daily, in lieu of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. as restricted by Commercial Corner regulations.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 21082.1(c)(3) of the California Public Resources Code, adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the above referenced project.

The purpose of this hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations.

Exhaustion of Administrative Remedies: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.
