Director's Public Hearing - Certificate of Appropriateness: Case No.: DIR-2016-1453-COA-SPP and ENV-2016-1454-MND Project Address and Description – 1342 W Adams Blvd

Rehabilitate and convert three existing buildings to charter school. Interior renovation of church, retention of full height sanctuary space and exterior details of structure. Rehabilitation, maintenance and repair of exterior of residence structure, and rehabilitation of interior lobby area. Accessibility ramp to be included at front of residence and screened by low hedge; new exit stair to be added. Two entrance ramps to be added to accessory structure. New uncovered patio area between structures. New landscape/hardscape on site and parkway, including new driveway apron and new driveway gate. 22 new parking spaces.

*Under provisions in Section 12.20.3 I (Notice and Public Hearing) of the Municipal Code, the owners and occupants of all properties abutting, across the street or alley from, or having a common corner with the subject property shall receive notice of the application for Certificate of Appropriateness at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the Director's meeting.
