PROJECT LOCATION: 3911 S. Figueroa Street. The area generally bounded by Exposition Boulevard on the north, Figueroa Street on the east, Martin Luther King Junior Boulevard on the south and Vermont Avenue on the west, plus the Existing Major Site Sign located easterly of the110 (Harbor) Freeway. The Specific Plan area <u>does not include</u> the EXPO Center, which includes the LA84 Foundation / John C. Argue Swim Stadium, and those portions of Exposition Park north of the Coliseum and Christmas Tree Lane north of Exposition Park

Drive containing the Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County, the California Science Center, the California African American Museum, and Jesse Brewer Jr. Park.

PROJECT PROPOSED: A request to amend the Coliseum District Specific Plan and approval of a Development Agreement.

REQUESTED ACTIONS:

On behalf of the City Planning Commission, the Hearing Officer will consider:

Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Renovation Project EIR:

 Pursuant to Section 21082.1(c) of the California Public Resources Code, the adequacy of the previously certified Environmental Impact Report, First Addendum, Second Addendum and Errata, findings, Statement of Overriding Considerations and accompanying mitigation measures and Mitigation Monitoring Program for the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Renovation Project EIR (SCH No. 1990011065);

CPC-2016-4382-SP:

 Pursuant to the procedures set forth in Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 11.5.7, a Specific Plan Amendment to modify the language of the Coliseum District Specific Plan for Section 8.C and

CPC-2016-3632-DA:

3. Pursuant to California Government Code Sections 65864-68869.5, the Applicant seeks to enter into a **Development Agreement** with the City of Los Angeles.

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The Hearing Officer will consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations. Following the hearing, the Hearing Officer will prepare Recommendation Reports for Case Nos. CPC-2016-4382-SP and CPC-2016-3632-DA to the City Planning Commission for its consideration, actions, and recommendations.

<u>EIR CERTIFICATION</u>: An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been prepared for this project, as described above, to assess potential environmental impacts. The EIR was certified by the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Commission (LAMCC), which is the Lead Agency, in December 2003. An EIR is comprised of two parts, the Draft EIR and the Final EIR. A Draft EIR was made available and circulated for public review and comment, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Final EIR responds to the comments and includes text revisions to the Draft EIR in response to input received on the Draft EIR.

Following certification of the EIR, several modifications were proposed for the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Renovation Project, including changes to the architectural design, the establishment of a Coliseum District Specific Plan, the adoption of a signage plan and the approval of the sale and dispensing of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption, that were addressed in the First Addendum to the Project EIR. The First Addendum was approved by the LAMCC on May 2, 2006.

Additional modifications were proposed for the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Renovation Project, including an amendment to the Coliseum District Specific Plan, a reduction in the number of luxury suites from 200 to 44, a reduction in the size of the press box from 25,000 to 17,400 square feet, a reduction in the concession-related facilities from 35,000 to 24,500 square feet and a reduction in seats from 92,500 to 78,000 seats, that were addressed in the Second Addendum to the Project EIR. The Second Addendum was approved by the LAMCC on July 28, 2016.

The LAMCC will act on further modifications to the project, including modified locations for two new scoreboards, a new sign and a new two-story ancillary building, and Errata prior to December 21, 2016. For more information on

LAMCC's meetings, go to <u>http://lamcc.lacounty.gov/Meetings</u>. The EIR, First Addendum, Second Addendum and Errata will be submitted to the City Planning Commission and City Council for approval and action on the project.

EXHAUSTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.
