The Zoning Administrator will consider: **REQUESTED ACTION:** 

- Pursuant to Section 12.24-W,1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, a Conditional Use Permit to allow for 1. the sale and dispensing of beer and wine for off-site sales in conjunction with an existing 1,130 squareconvenience store and service station having 24-hour operations.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 21084 of the California Public Resources Code, the above referenced project has been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall therefore be exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

The purpose of this hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations.
