Overview & Project Area

The Department of City Planning (DCP) is developing a Streetscape Plan for Century Boulevard in conjunction with Los Angeles World Airports. To create new guidelines for streetscape improvements in the public right-of-way, the guidelines include: expanding sidewalks; introducing new street trees; street furniture and street lights; and creating new public gathering spaces. By establishing such guidelines, the Century Boulevard Streetscape Plan aims to improve the pedestrian experience along Century Boulevard by creating a more amenity – rich area for employees and visitors.

The Century Boulevard Streetscape Plan boundary extends from Sepulveda Boulevard to La Cienega Boulevard on Century Boulevard within the Westchester – Playa Del Rey Community Plan Area.

What is the intent of the Streetscape Plan?

The Century Boulevard Streetscape Plan will enhance and redefine Century Boulevard by establishing unified and distinctive street elements to guide the implementation of future streetscape improvements. The objectives of the plan include:

- Enhance and redefine Century Boulevard as the “Gateway to Los Angeles” by creating a sense of place.
- Enrich the pedestrian experience for visitors, hotel guests, and office employees.
- Create a high quality pedestrian environment where existing and future businesses can thrive.
- Improve the district’s pedestrian connectivity to the regional Metro rail system, local hotels and offices, and the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX).

What are the next steps for this Streetscape Plan?

On December 7, 2017 an Open House and Public Hearing will be held. During the Public Hearing, a Hearing Officer will take public testimony and accept written correspondence on the proposed plan. A written recommendation report will subsequently be prepared by Department of City Planning staff for approval by the City Planning Commission and the Board of Public Works at a later date.

How will the streetscape plan be implemented?

The plan is intended to be implemented incrementally over time by a combination of public improvements and private development projects.
