# PROPOSED PROJECT:

Time

The sale of a full line of alcohol for on-site consumption in conjunction with an existing, 2,262 square-foot cocktail lounge that sells a full line of alcohol, with an expansion of a new restaurant use and 2,638 square feet for a total of 4,900 square feet. The project's expansion involves a change-of use of 1.785 square feet from retail to restaurant, and an increased parking requirement of 11 parking spaces, which will be satisfied through bike parking spaces as well as an in-lieu monthly parking deficiency fee pursuant to Section 7.F.2 of the Ventura/Cahuenga Boulevard Corridor Specific Plan. New signage is also proposed.

# **REQUESTED ACTION(S):**

- 1. Based on the whole of the administrative record, the Project is exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Article III, Section 1, and Class 3 and Category1, and Class 5 and Category 23 of the City of Los Angeles CEQA Guidelines, for the granting of a conditional use for a non-significant use of land, and there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception to a categorical exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 applies;
- 2. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code 12.24 W.1 (a) Conditional Use Permit to allow the sale and dispensation of full line of alcohol for on-site consumption in conjunction with a restaurant and front patio having 96 indoor seats and 10 outdoor seats, with proposed hours of operation Monday to Thursday 11 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., and Friday to Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.;
- 3. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 11.5.7 C, a Project Permit Compliance for the Ventura/ Cahuenga Boulevard Specific Plan for a change of use that requires an increase in parking requirements, the option to pay the in-lieu fee through the Ventura/Cahuenga Specific Plan for four (4) parking spaces, and new signage.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**TESTIMONY AND CORRESPONDENCE** - Your attendance is optional; oral testimony can only be given at the public hearing and may be limited due to time constraints. Written testimony or evidentiary documentation may be submitted prior to the hearing. Decision-makers such as Associate Zoning Administrators or Commissions function in a quasi-judicial capacity and therefore, cannot be contacted directly. Any materials submitted to the Department or Commission become City property and will not be returned. This includes any correspondence or exhibits used as part of your testimony.

Be advised that the Commission may RECONSIDER and alter its action taken on items listed on the meeting agenda at any time during this meeting or during the next regular meeting, in accordance with the Commission Policies and Procedures and provided that the Commission retains jurisdiction over the case. If a Commission meeting is cancelled or adjourned due to lack of quorum, all remaining agenda items shall be continued to the next regular meeting or beyond, as long as the continuance is within the legal time limits of the case or cases.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION OF MATERIALS -** Written testimony may be submitted via email, in person or by U.S. mail to the staff identified on the front of this page. Correspondence should be presented on letter size (8 ½ " x 11") or legal size (8 ½ " x 14") paper. All oversized exhibits <u>must be folded</u> to fit into a legal-sized folder. Plans (i.e. site plans, floor plans, grading plans) must be presented on paper size not smaller than ledger size (11" x 17"). The case number must be written on all communications, plans and exhibits. **To the extent possible, please also submit all materials electronically (flash drive, CD or via email).** 

#### **Regular Submissions**

- <u>Matters before Commissions</u>: Written materials not limited as to volume must be <u>received</u> ten (10) days prior to the hearing date. Provide an original plus twelve (12) copies of all correspondence or exhibits. You may submit written testimony to the Commission Office directly at 200 North Spring Street, Room 532, Los Angeles, CA 90012 in attention to the Commission Secretariat.
- <u>Matters before an Associate Zoning Administrator (AZA) or Hearing Officer:</u> Written materials not limited as to volume must be <u>received</u> no later than **five (5) days** prior to the hearing date. Provide an **original** plus **(3) copies**, and follow the size guidelines above.

**Rebuttal Submissions -** All written materials in response to a Recommendation Report and/or additional comments must be submitted no later than **48 hours** before the hearing date. Submissions, including exhibits, shall not exceed ten (10) pages.

**Day of Hearing Submissions -** Submissions less than 48 hours prior to, and including the day of the hearing, must not exceed two (2) written pages, including exhibits. Photographs do not count toward the page limitation. Notwithstanding, the Associate Zoning Administrator or Hearing Officer may deviate from this requirement at their discretion.

**Non-Complying Submissions** - Submissions that do not comply with these rules will be stamped "File Copy. Non-complying Submission". Non-complying submissions will be placed into the official case file, but they will not be delivered to, or considered by the Commission, Associate Zoning Administrator or Hearing Officer. Notwithstanding, the Associate Zoning Administrator or Hearing Officer may deviate from this requirement at their discretion.
