We have reviewed the Water Supply Assessment (WSA) Request Letter for the Crossroads Hollywood Project (Proposed Project). Based on our review of the scope description provided in your request letter, the following items listed below require further clarification/details in order for us to continue with our water demand analyses for the referenced project:

General:

- 1. General Plan: Please confirm Proposed Project will not require a General Plan amendment.
