We have been residents of the Hollywood Dell for over 28 years and are in strong opposition to the newly renamed Hollywood Center Project. If this is allowed to pass, we consider that it will be a certain disaster with a long term, far-reaching negative impact on our community. It is no accident that this project has changed its name from its original name: The Millennium Project, because the tower this same company built in San Francisco sunk and started to lean! As a result, the citizens of San Francisco are forced to shell out precious funds for the requisite lawsuit.

We do not want our beloved Hollywood to have anything to do with such a irresponsible, reprehensible company, or any project they propose. Their past actions prove that their concern is only making money for themselves, and not at all about the citizens who inhabit the area where they construct.
