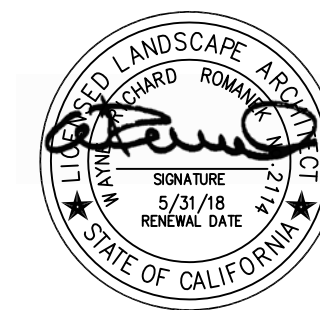

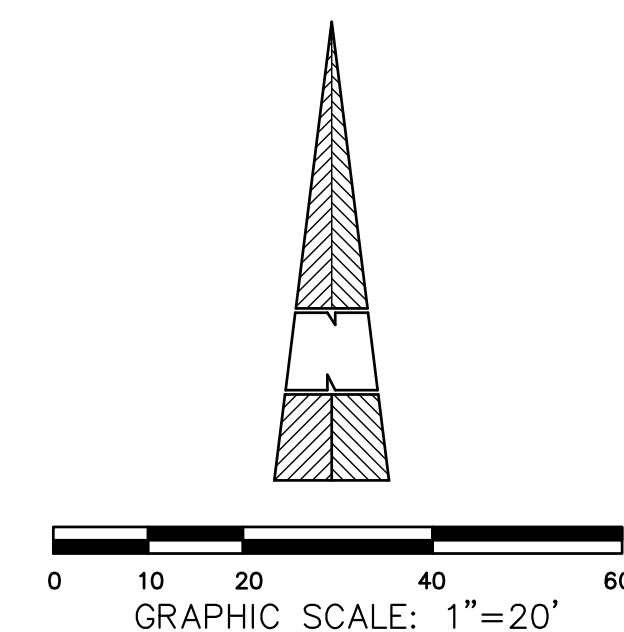
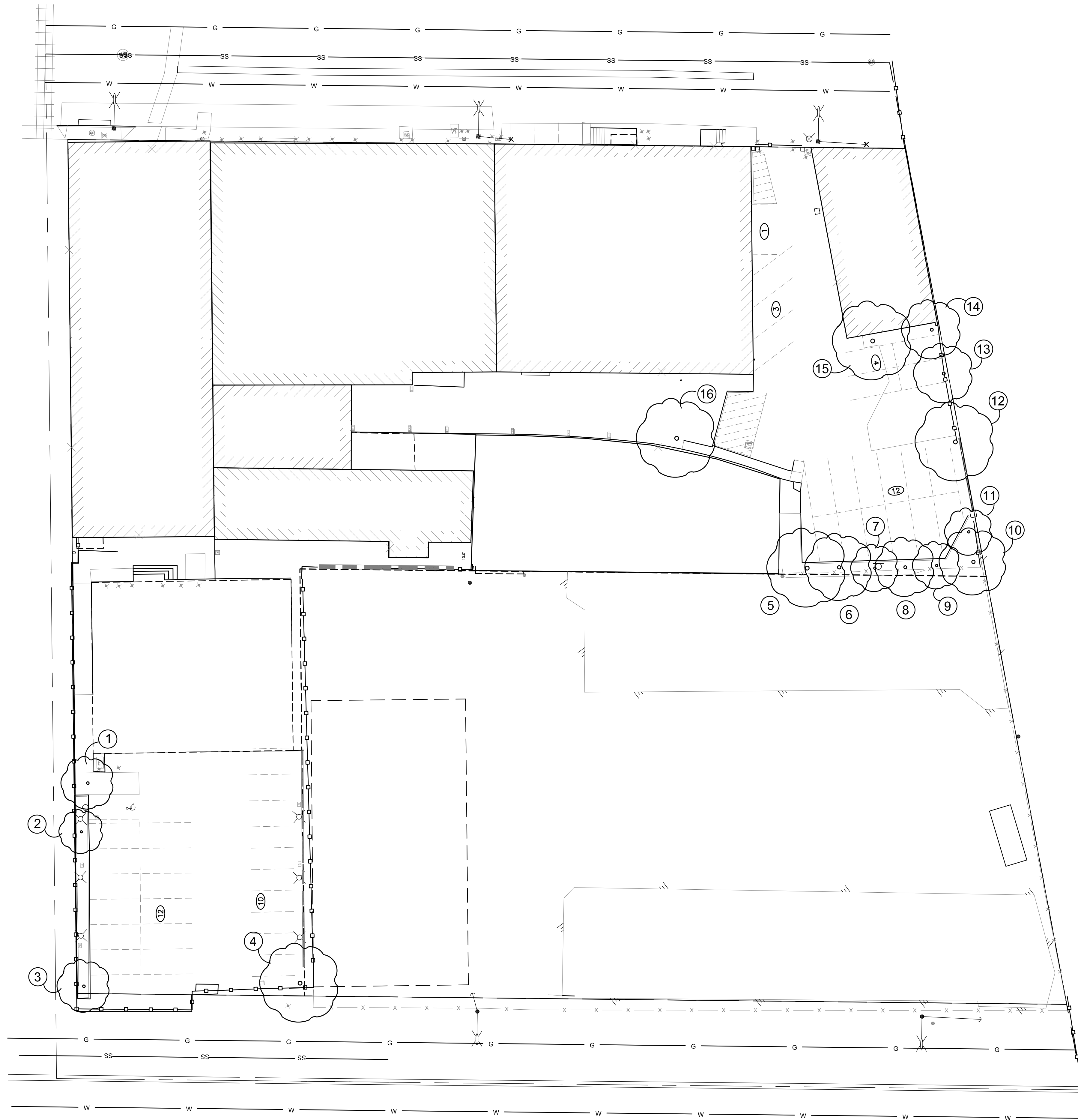

- (2) TREES SO NOTED ARE IN VERY POOR CONDITION DUE TO EXTREME DROUGHT DROUGHT STRESS AND LACK OF IRRIGATION. CONDITION IS POOR.
- (3) PLATANUS RACEMOSA IS A PROTECTED NATIVE TREE IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES. ITS PROTECTION IS REGULATED BY CITY ORDINANCE No. 177404 ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF URBAN FORESTRY, BUREAU OF STREET SERVICES.
