ORDINANCE NO. 176156

An ordinance amending Section .12.04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code by amending the zoning map.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12.04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is hereby amended by changing the zones and zone boundaries shown upon a portion of the zone map attached thereto and made a part of Article 2, Chapter 1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, so that such portion of the zoning map shall be as follows:

PICO UNION HISTORIC PRESERVATION OVERLAY ZONE

ALL ZONES AND HEIGHT DISTRICTS IN THE AFFECTED AREA REMAIN THE SAME. SUFFIX HPOZ WAS ADDED BECAUSE AREA IS NOW INCLUDED IN A HISTORIC PRESERVATION OVERLAY ZONE. ALL BOUNDARIES FOLLOW EXISTING LINES, EXCEPT WHERE DIMENSIONED.

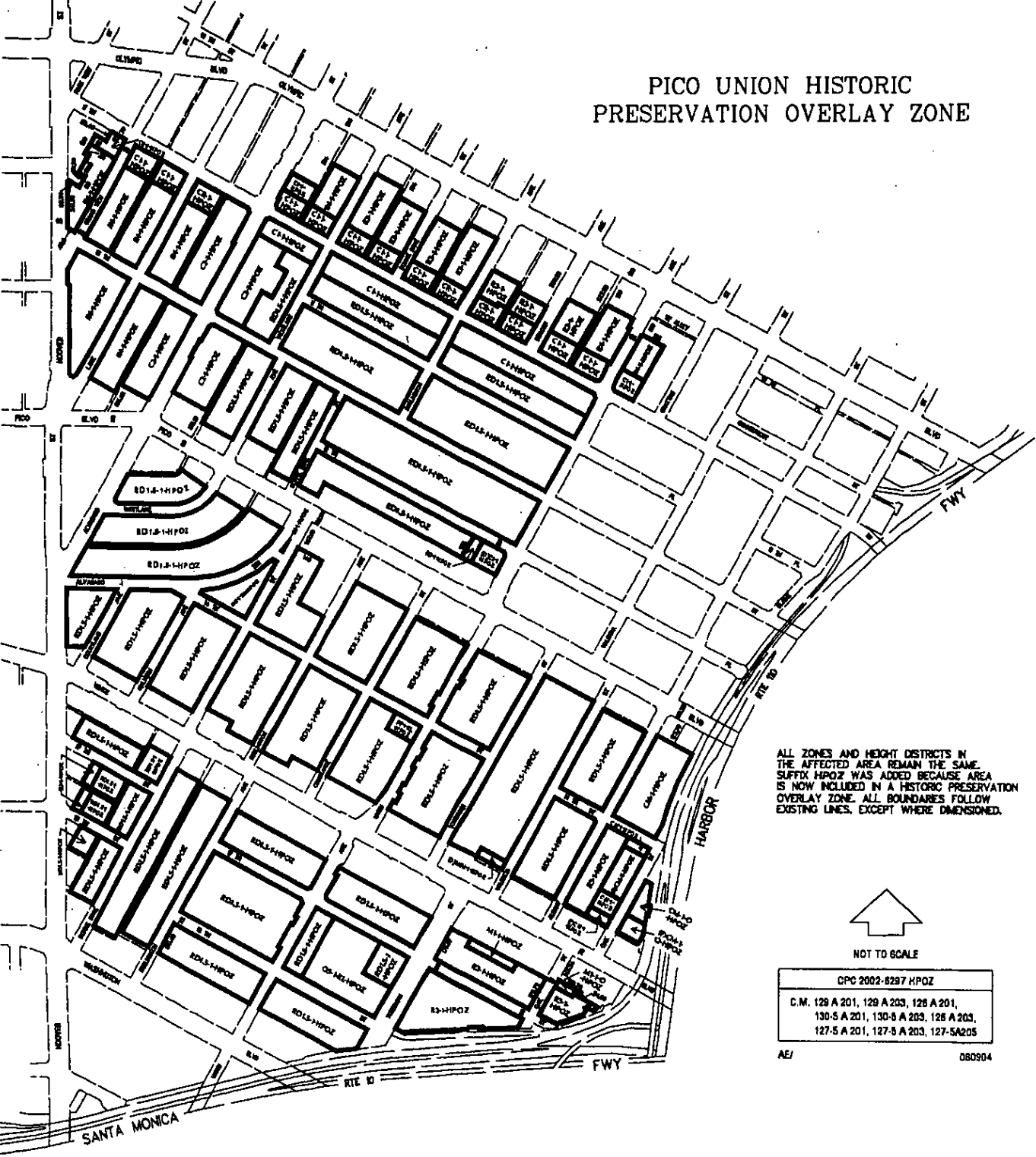


NOT TO SCALE

Sec. 2. DECLARATION OF POSTING ORDINANCE

I, MARIA C. RICO, state as follows: I am, and was at all times hereinafter mentioned, a resident of the State of California, over the age of eighteen years, and a Deputy City Clerk of the City of Los Angeles, California.
