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City Planning Continues Deliberation on the Community Plan and Zoning for Downtown Sept. 23

LOS ANGELES—On Sept. 23, the Los Angeles City Planning Commission (CPC) will continue its deliberations on the proposed update to the Downtown Community Plan and the neighborhood's new zoning.

Downtown is projected to gain 125,000 new residents and 55,000 new jobs by 2040. The proposed Plan and zoning changes aim to accommodate this growth in an inclusive, equitable, sustainable, and healthy manner, prioritizing the production of affordable housing and employment opportunities. Among other changes, the Plan would nearly double the area where residential uses are permitted, increasing it from 33% to 60% of Downtown.
